1. Come watch a race at the National Guard Armory in Superior, WI (32 N. 21st, Superior, WI 54880). This is a great time to take in the racing format and wander the pit areas. Feel free to say “Hi” and ask questions.

Racing Etiquette

- 1) Register to race online and pay race fees ASAP.
- 2) Refrain from using profanity and crude language.
- 3) Alcohol is prohibited during races.
- 4) Stay on the drivers stand until your race heat has concluded.
- 5) Proceed directly to a corner marshalling position after your race heat finishes.
- 6) Children must be supervised at all times. Please ensure they keep out of off-limits areas and behave appropriately.
- 7) Verbal abuse of corner marshals will not be tolerated.
- 8) Use the grievance form to notify club officers of issues immediately.
